 in hysse. w^{ch} is Twentie two poyntes ffyftene shillinge, w^{ch} I hope is well for me. I
 doe beleve hysse that be better abel will not doe so. Therefore I doe desire hysse to pardon
 anything myne, I would to God I could have com more, but my charge is great
 and charge doth not frame wth me as I would hysse did, hysse leaving hysse world, all my
 good frendes. The worshipfull company of hysse wintres w^{ch} I was first graffe
 w^{ch} all and so brought w^{ch} I pray God to blisse you all in hysse world and in hysse world
 to come. A dwelling place of hysse everlastinge and I hysse same, I pray to God my maker
 and to hysse spirit our Redeemer in hysse world and in hysse world to come. hysse everlastinge
 Amen, hysse is a true will made by my selfe beinge in good memorie, and upon ad nite
 ad firm to please God and hysse world. By me William Darter, Woblyste, Declared

 County of North. Widow beinge w^{ch} in body and of perfect memory he asked be
 given to Almighty God for the same. Doth make and ordaine hysse my last will
 and Testament in manner and forme followinge. In primis I bequeath my soule into
 the hands of Almighty God my Creator, and my body to the earth from whence it
 came expectinge through the merittes of hysse spirit my Redeemer to be made partaker
 of life everlastinge. Then I give and bequeath to the parson of the parish of Eastwoodham
 in the County of South Twentie shillinge of lawfull English money to be paid w^{ch}
 paymente next after my decease. Then I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Richard
 Fretwell the sone of Twentie poyntes of lawfull money of England to be paid unto
 him w^{ch} in or at the end of hysse monethes next after my decease. Then I give and
 bequeath unto James Darter sone of Elizabeth Darter sister to my late husband
 Darter w^{ch} in the County of North Twentie the sone of ffyve poyntes of
 lawfull English money to be paid unto him w^{ch} in hysse monethes next after my
 decease. I give to the said James Darter be hysse of hysse full age of one and Twentie
 years. Then I give and bequeath unto Margarett Darter daughter of the foresaid
 Elizabeth Darter the sone of ffyve poyntes of lawfull English money to be paid unto
 her w^{ch} in hysse monethes next after my decease. I give to the said Margarett be hysse of
