 said Henry Williams and his heirs, and all other the mtsuaged lands tennt and hereditamentts
 whatsover with thappurtenances which I have or ought to have in yslaph aforesaid to have and to
 hold all the said premises to the aforesaid Henry Williams my sonne and to the heirs male of his
 bodie lawfullie begotten. The remainder thereof in default of such issue to bee and remaine to my right
 heirs for ever. Item I give devise and bequeath, to the said Henry Williams my younger sonne eight
 open with the plough) and plough irons and other incidentts belonginge therunto allsoe twentie
 four milsh fine with thire calves and a bull to followe them allsoe twelve beaste of thire and
 four yeares old, a mare and two fillies a doult of thire yeares old, and thire score sheepe
 Item I give devise and bequeath, to my said sonne Henry Williams two feather beddes, two
 coverlitts, a goblett of silver, six silver spoons with a brassen matter and pettle out bedsted
 Item I give and bequeath, to the said Henry Williams the summe of one hundredth pounde of currant
 monny of England. Item I doe make ordaine, constitute and appoint my eldest sonne and heir
 Thomas Williams to bee my lawfull true and sole Exeutor of this my last will & testament
 to order and dispose my goods and to execute thio my last will and testament in all pointes &
 articles thereof, as I repose in him my speciall confidence to whom after my debts paid, my funerall
 expences discharged and all and singuler my legacies performed I give and bequeath the rest and
 residue of all and singuler my goods Chattells Chattells and Creditts whatsover And as for my
 eldest daughter Elizabeth Williams and her marriage portion, her eldest brother the said
 Thomas Williams hath already given her service for the same And I doe hereby reserve her
 for further augmentacion of her marriage portion to her said brother Thomas Williams as
 he shall thinke convenient whom I hope will love out of his naturall love and affection towards
 her) wth her kindly and lovingly. Item I doe by thio my last will and testament utterly revoke
 annulle and make frustrate all and everie other former Testaments and wills
 before by me made In witness whereof I have caused thio my last will and testament to bee
 written, and to the same have putt my scale and subscribed my name the date and yfart above

 thire and twentieth daie of Aprill Anno domini one thousand six hundred & thirtie
 And in the sixt yeare of the Reigne of our Sovereign lord Charles by the grace of god
 Kinge of England Scotland France and Ireland defender of the faith &c. I John
 Carter Citizen and dwitner of London beinge at thio present here and weake in bodie but
 of good soule and perfect minde and memory praise bee given to god for the same knowinge the
 certaintie of death and the uncertaintie of the tyme and houre thereof doe therefore make
 ordaine and declare thio my last will and testament in manner and forme followinge, that is
 to say, first and principallie I comitt and comitt my soule into the hande of Almighty
 god my Creator and maker, of his sonne Jesus Christ my onely Saviour and redemer, and
 of the holy ghost my Sanctifier, and Comforter, thire distinct persons but out true, and

ever livinge God assuredly trustinge and stedfastly believing that I shalbe saved and have full and
 full pardon and forgiveness of all my sinnes by and through the only meritts death and passion of my
 lord and Saviour Iesus Christ and by none other means what so ever My bodie I commit to the
 earth from whence it came to be decently buried in Christchurch London as next to my late wife
 as maie bet And my will and munde is that all such debts and somes of monye as I shall truly owe
 stand indebted or owe to any person or persons at the tyme of my decease shalbe paid by my Executor
 hereunder named And after my debts and funerall expences shalbe paid and discharged I give e-
 bequeath to the poore of the parish of Christchurch aforesaid forty shillings to be distributed and
 given amongst them according to the discretion of the churchwardens and Overseers of the
 said parish for the tyme beinge Item I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Cooper and Elizabeth Foster
 my Servant Twentie shillings apeece Item I give and bequeath to my Executor hereunder
 named Twentie shillings Item I give and bequeath to my Overseers hereunder named twentie
 shillings apeece Item I will that my whole estate shalbe divided into thre equall partes accordinge
 to the custome of the Citie of London One equall third part whercof I give and bequeath to
 my wife to her owne proper use and behoofe for ever One other equall third yte
 whercof I give and bequeath to my Children viz George William John Thomas Robert
 Anne Elizabeth Mary Silvester and Isabell Carter equalle to be divided parte and parte
 like amongst them and to be paid by my Executor when and at such tyme and tyme as they
 shall severally and respectively attaine the age of one and Twentie yeares And if it shall
 happen any of my said Children to die before they shall attaine their said age of one & twentie
 yeares as aforesaid Then I will and my meaninge is that the partes and portions of my estate of
 him her or them soe dyinge shall remaine and come unto the Survivors or Survivor of my
 said Children and to be paid by my Executor at their age of one and twentie yeares as a
 aforesaid Item I give and bequeath out of the remainder of my estate unto my forsaide sonne
 George twentie poundes and the remainder thereof to him and the other of my said Children
 equalle to be paid as aforesaid and with the like limitation or condition as is above expressed
 And I will that the benefitt and profitt wher shall arise or maie be made of my said Childrens
 portions shalbe expended by my Executor for their education and preferment And if any of my
 shalbe that the same shalbe equalle divided to and amongst them as above said And of this my
 last will and testament I doe make my soveraigne brother in lawe Gabriell Benion Citizen &
 Allowhandler of London full and sole Executor And Overseers thereof I doe ordaine and
 appoint my very lovinge friends William Harte Citizen and Wintur of London Robert
 Darre Citizen and Ironmonger of London whom I doe desire to be, aydinge and assistinge
 to my said Executor in the executinge thereof for the good of my said wife and Children In
 witness whereof to this my last will and Testament I the said John Carter have sett my hand
 and seal the daie and yeaere abovesayd John Carter Signed sealed pronounced and
 declared by the within named John Carter the testator for his last will and testament the thirte
 and twentieth daie of April one thousand six hundred and thirtie in the presence of Robert
 Dawbitt the marke of Margarett Thomas and John Sharpe Jurors And that their words (out
 of) sonne George twentie poundes and the remainder thereof to him and the other of my said
 betwene the one and twentieth and twentieth lires within written were interlined before
 their sealinge herof and afterwards read in purt of the witnesses abovesayd .i.
